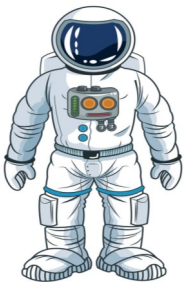

Registration is now open for Chess Club and something new: Rubik's Cube Club!

Did You Know?

An astronaut is a person who is specially trained to travel into outer space. Astronauts aboard a spacecraft may have different responsibilities. Typically there is a commander who leads the mission and a pilot. Other positions may include flight engineer, payload commander, mission specialist, and science pilot. Astronauts have to undergo extensive training and testing before they can participate in a spaceflight. They must show that they can handle the physical rigors from the high gravity of launch to the weightlessness of orbit. They also must be technically knowledgeable and able to handle stressful situations that may arise during the mission. An astronaut can be up to 2 inches taller returning from space (the cartilage disks in the spine expand in the absence of gravity).

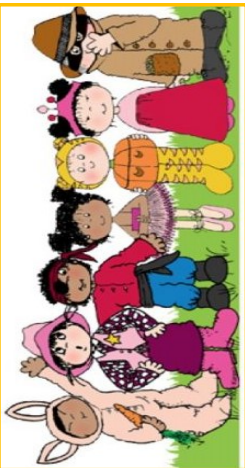
K-2 SCHOOL SPIRIT: HAT DAY
