This year the Spring Fair will be at Whitney Ave location! Stay tuned for opportunities to volunteer for this special event!

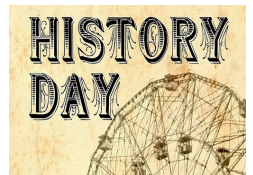
