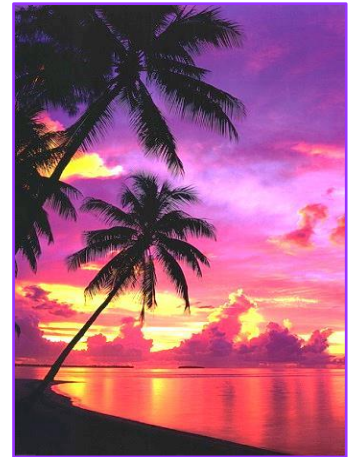

PICK UP & DROP OFF

It is extremely important that drop off and pick up times are observed. Please have your child to school on time. **All students must be picked up promptly at 2:50 PM everyday** unless they are attending after school programs. For early dismissal all students must be picked up promptly at 12:50 PM.

REMINDER

At the beginning of the school year our team presented our school expectations to all students based on district policy in regards to food and technology use in class. I would like to remind everyone of the following:

FOOD POLICY
