#### Chinese Program

Ni-hao! We offer Chinese language classes for Hooker students in grades K-2. Classes are held at the Lower School on Wednesday from 4:00 p.m. – 5:30 p.m. Classes are taught by an experienced teacher with recognized experience in foreign language education for children. The program is based on the immersion approach to teaching. Children are taught through storytelling, song, dance, play, and creative art. Snacks and all materials are provided. The fee is \$8 per class for children enrolled in the After School Program, and \$15 per class for children not enrolled in the After School Program.
